“The Stories of Jesus: Then and Now!”

“The Stories of Jesus: Then and Now” continues for a couple more weeks as a focus for summer - through September 8 to be precise.

As we approach the summer season’s end, we’ll reflect upon a curious scene from Jesus’ life with the disciples – an unexpected encounter in another country which leads to a broadened message for them and for us. The story as told by Matthew in his chapter 15, recounts the time when a woman from Syro-phenicia (modern Lebanon) accosts the Lord. At first he rebuffs her. But, on further exchange, she reveals her faith and in so doing creates a challenge to rethink who is ‘us’ and who ‘them.’ What are the meanings and messages from a compelling Gospel account which engenders an unexpected responsibility? “The Disciples’ Foreign Debt” is the sermon title. And what difference does it make?
