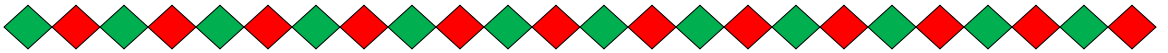


Announcements and Church Information

Mission Commission continues to accept food donations for **Lunch Break**. Their need for donated food has dramatically increased now because of sudden substantially reduced funding. Here's what they urgently need:

Non-Perishable Food: Canned beans, dried beans, low-sodium canned soup (chicken, vegetable, and tomato), oatmeal, canned meals (spaghetti, ravioli, chili), canned chicken, canned tuna, canned vegetables (corn, peas, carrots), low-sugar applesauce, and almond or oat milk.

Toiletries and Supplies: Toothbrushes & toothpaste, deodorant, shampoo, body wash, dish soap (smaller sizes), laundry detergent, baby diapers (sizes 2-6), baby wipes, and adult diapers (women sizes L, XL, XXL).

Game and Book Drive for Malawi Students

Malawi is known as 'The Heart of Africa' and is also one of the very poorest countries in the world. I am collecting items for two schools in a village in Malawi.

For a boys' weekday boarding high school I am collecting travel games for the boys to play in their free time in the evenings. Examples include, but definitely not limited to, Uno and other card games, travel Connect 4, word searches, checkers, and backgammon and puzzles 100-500 pieces.

In another school for youngsters ages 3-6, their teacher is asking for books about animals,

planets, dinosaurs, numbers, etc.
